ordinance no. 1996-9

ORDINANCE CREATING NO PARKING ZONES ON ELM STREET, MAPLE STREET, AND LARIMER DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to promote the beautification of the Town of Millersburg, traffic safety and the free flow of traffic;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 9-21-1-2 and -3 authorize a local authority to regulate the parking of vehicles with respect to streets and highways under its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to promote beautification, traffic safety, and the orderly flow of traffic along portions of Elm Street, Maple Street, and Larimer Drive in the Town of Millersburg;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ESTABLISHED, AND ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Millersburg, Indiana as follows:

- 1. Parking is prohibited on the south side of Elm Street and fifteen (15) feet south of the south edge of the Elm Street pavement from the intersection of Jefferson and Elm Street for a distance of one thousand (1,000) feet east along Elm Street.
- 2. Parking is prohibited on the south side of Maple Street and fifteen (15) feet south of the south edge of the Maple Street pavement.
- 3. Parking is prohibited on the west side of Larimer Drive and fifteen (15) feet west of the west edge of the Larimer Drive pavement. See Minutes of M. 20, 1997
- 4. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) fine shall be imposed for a violation of this Ordinance.
- 5. Revenues generated from such fines for violations of this Ordinance shall be deposited in the general fund of the Town of Millersburg, Indiana.
- 6. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage by the Town Council and publication according to law.
